

Intervention logic






Programme preparation

Establish a coherent link between CMES elements




 Establish a functional data collection and monitoring system

Type of interventions

- currently there are 16 types of interventions under discussion
- used to allocate funds along thematic policy issues;
- used to track climate change and environmental expenditure;
- should be selected select **under each specific objective** in accordance with the defined types of actions, and indicatively allocate so that funds are indicatively allocated to each of them;
- MAs freely choose as many types of interventions per SO as necessary;
- during implementation a type of intervention should be chosen for each operation CPR Article 37.




Types of operations



- pre-determined list of thematic categories used to label/categorize single operations for monitoring in Infosys;
- final list will be determined in a future legal supporting act following the final regulation;
- during implementation, Member States select the most appropriate type of operation for each operation;
- only one type of operation is possible per operation;
- for complex operations, MA must choose the most representative one.




Reporting process
