#### Why Sea Basin Analyses?

- The Regional Sea Basin Analyses provide a sea basin perspective to guide the post-2020 programming period for the future EMFF
- They identify key common challenges for each sea basin and focus on possible EMFF actions to respond to them
- They are intended to complement MS own programming process as additional background, along with the national SWOT analyses, and are based on the most recent scientific data



#### Content

The Sea Basin Analyses are composed of 3 main parts:

- an introduction: main CFP challenges at EU level
- 7 regional chapters: in-depth analyses of each sea basin
- an annex ('EMFF toolbox'): possible actions supported by the EMFF matching the main CFP challenges

They are in line with the Commission's main political priorities for 2021-2027 (EU Green Deal, Biodiversity and Farm to Fork strategies, etc..) and address the impact of the COVID-19 crisis on the fisheries sector



# Introduction Overview of the main CFP challenges at EU level

- 1) Reducing the **impacts of fishing on ecosystems**
- Providing conditions for an economically viable and competitive fishing sector
- Improving enforcement and control of fisheries and the provision of data
- 4) Promoting a sustainable and profitable aquaculture
- 5) Enabling climate change adaptation and mitigation
- 6) Improving the value chain and marketing of fishery and aquaculture products
- 7) Fostering the **local development of a sustainable blue economy** in coastal areas

#### **Regional chapters**

**In-depth Analyses of Sea Basin** 

On the basis of the main CFP challenges, the regional chapters provide a specific assessment of the strengths and weaknesses at sea basin level


#### They cover the following **geographical areas**:
