1. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO SANDEEL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

On 28 February 2023, ICES published its scientific advice¹ for sandeel (*Ammodytes spp.*) in ICES subarea 4 (North Sea) and division 3a (Skagerrak and Kattegat) - in sandeel management areas 1r, 2r, 3r, 4, 5r, 6, and 7r in those ICES zones - for 2023.

Following the publication of that advice, bilateral consultations between the EU and the UK on the level of the TAC for 2023 for that stock, listed in Annex 35 of the Trade and Cooperation Agreement² (TCA) were held pursuant to Articles 498(2), (4) and (6) of the TCA. Those consultations were conducted between 9 March and 13 March 2023, and on the basis of the general principles and the specific orientations for consultations with the UK in Council Decision (EU) 2021/1875³, and the approach outlined in the Commission services non-paper as endorsed by the Council on 2 March 2023. Those consultations were conducted, on the EU side, by the Commission in coordination with the Council. The European Parliament was informed as appropriate.

The outcome of those consultations was documented in a Written Record. The EU and the UK agreed to set the TAC in sandeel management areas 1r and 4 slightly below the level in the scientific advice, while in the other sandeel management areas, the EU and the UK agreed to set the TAC fully in line with the scientific advice. It is therefore proposed to set the TAC for sandeel and associated by-catches in UK and EU waters of ICES subarea 4, UK waters of ICES division 2a and EU waters of division 3a for 2023 at the level agreed with the UK.

AMENDMENTS TO THE RECITALS

Recital (3) is replaced by the following:

"(3) Between 9 and 13 March 2023, bilateral consultations between the Union and the United Kingdom on the level of the TAC for sandeel and associated by-catches (*Ammodytes spp.*) in United Kingdom and Union waters of ICES subarea 4, United Kingdom waters of ICES

division 2a and Union waters of division 3a were conducted. Those consultations were conducted pursuant to Article 498(2), (4) and (6) of the Trade and Cooperation Agreement⁴ (TCA) and on the basis of the Union position endorsed by the Council on 2 March 2023. The outcome of those consultations was documented in a Written Record. The relevant TAC should therefore be set at the level agreed with the United Kingdom."
