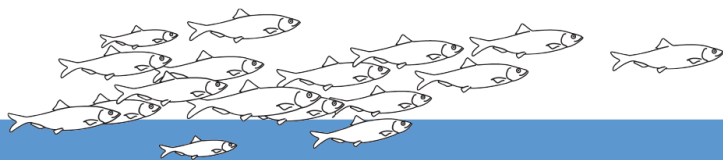
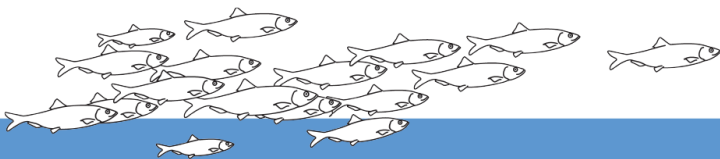


# Sweden's experiences on the Evaluation Plans and next steps



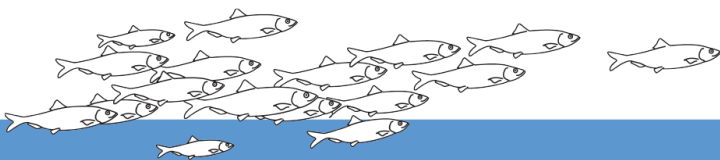
# What have we learned so far from developing the evaluation plan for Sweden?

- Planning enables:
  - Framework agreements and cooperation agreements (we know who will do the evaluations)
  - Allocation of resources
- Established working processes ensures evaluations of the right quality at the right time and cost
- Dialogue with stakeholders and target groups are key for relevant evaluations



# What evaluation activities will be done in the next 6-12 months in Sweden?

- Ex-ante assessment - appropriateness of using financial instruments in the programme
  - soon published
- Process evaluation (2 reports)
  - start-up phase now
  - finish in March and May 2024
- Biodiversity; specific objectiv 1.6
  - determine scope, contract evaluators, approve their project plan
  - Finish in 2027
- Data and fisheries control; specific objectiv 1.4
  - determine scope, contract evaluators, approve their project plan
  - finish 2027



# What challenges do you foresee with evaluations in Sweden?

- Long-lasting cooperation
- Relatively small budget for each evaluation
- Broad approach with limited budget
