EUROPEAN MARITIME, FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE FUND (EMFAF)

Community-led Local Development (CLLD) under the EMFAF in Germany focuses on raising awareness of the value of locally produced food and ecological connections, as well as promoting permanent economic growth for the respective areas. It aims to strengthen local community ties, to preserve the cultural and historical heritage of fisheries and to promote maritime tourism and innovation to prepare local fisheries for the future. The well-established fisheries Local Action Groups of the 2014-2020 EMFF programming period have been continued under the EMFAF, with the number of LAGs increasing from 29 to 31 in total.

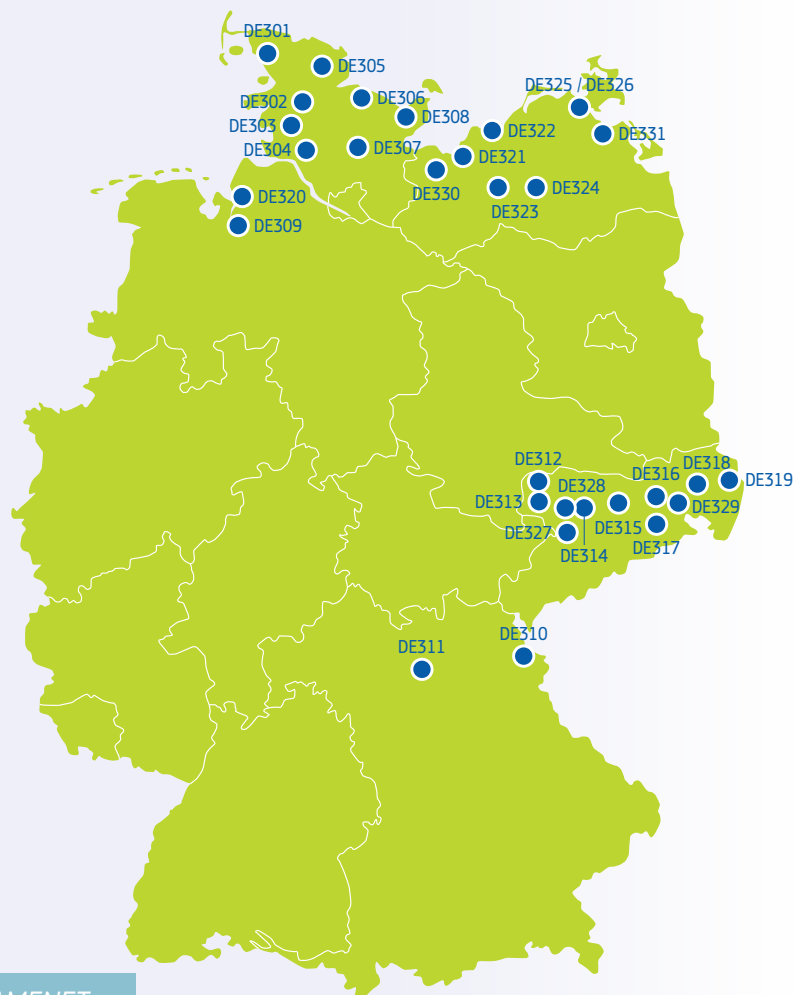
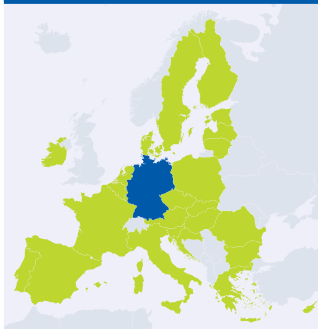
