# The Arcachon-Val de l'Éyre FLAG and CLLD

# Presentation – FLAG area



Founded by 3 intermunicipalities (COBAS, COBAN, CDC VE) and composed by 17 municipalities

A **cooperation tool** which aim to develop the assets of the territory and to reinforce solidarity

A **shared team** (8,5 FTEs)

The management of **2 local funds**: EFF-EMFAF and LEADER

A multiplicity of **skills** to develop the territory :  
agriculture/feeding, employment/formation,  
mobility, health/habitat,  
economical/social/environmental development

# More than 15 years of development experience

- 210 projects were supported, which represents almost 5M€ of European funding and 11M€ of investments in the territory

# The French National Networks

# The French National Network (*PACTE*) - EFF

- Fisheries and aquaculture at the heart of local areas
- Supported by the French national MA
- From 2010 to 2015
- Animated by the Paying Agency (ASP)
- 2 tasks :
  - Technical support: helped FLAG managers to understand the regulations and procedures
  - Networking: organization of 1 seminar/year in a FLAG area; to promote local projects and share experience (around 100 participants)
    - *NN covered costs of FLAGs' promotion tools (roll-ups, posters) and travel*



# The French National Network (DLAL-FEAMP) - EMFF

**DLAL FEAMP**

- Supported by the French Regions
- From 2018 to 2022
  - 1 FTE 2018 - 2020
  - Service provider 2020 - 2022
- 3 tasks :
  - promote the transfer of experience: website [www.dlalfeamp.fr](http://www.dlalfeamp.fr), 2 seminars
  - technical workshops with FLAG managers
  - Preparation for post-2020: information and participation

# The X-mas list for a perfect National Network

- Built in consultation with the FLAGs to be useful and used
- Strong link to the regional networks
- At least 2 dedicated full time people who have skills :
  - In fishery and aquaculture sectors
  - In local development
  - In regulations and procedures
  - In promotion/website
- 2 main tasks :
  - Technical: to help FLAG managers to understand regulations and procedures, to promote technical and thematic exchanges → *1 or 2 workshops/year*
  - Networking: to promote exchanges with stakeholders from all FLAGs → *1 seminar/year and magazines, website...*
- With a sufficient budget to cover travel costs and expenses related to posters, roll-ups, stands... of the FLAGs
