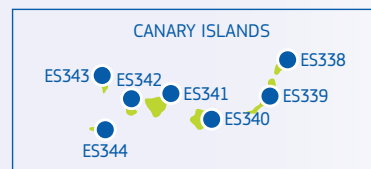
EUROPEAN MARITIME, FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE FUND (EMFAF)

With the new Blue Economy focus of EMFAF CLLD, Spain will seek to promote the sustainability of the marine and maritime sectors, taking advantage of the high potential of CLLD to create synergies between sectors. In particular, it aims to support the development of business activities in fields such as biotechnology and renewable energies, and boost training and the development of new technologies. Synergies between fishing and tourism will also be fostered to add value to local products and services, as well as to the socio-cultural heritage of the local coastal area. Likewise, the programme will aim to attract young people to the fisheries sector and build links with segments of the population that can bring added value to the marine sectors. Small-scale fisheries and aquaculture operators play an essential role in the Spanish Local Development Strategies, due to their strong presence and contribution to the local economies.
