From zero to the F/LAG Database (1)

1. Collection of the basic data:

- **EAFRD LAGs:** the ENRD Contact Point (CP) will send a **TEMPLATE** to fill in to the EAFRD MAs/NSUs of the NRNs,
- **EMFF FLAGs:** The CP will **coordinate actions with FARNET** for the collection of FLAGs information **on the basis of the FLAG factsheets.**

2. The CP will input the data received in the database.
LAG profiles and **LAG codes** will be automatically created.

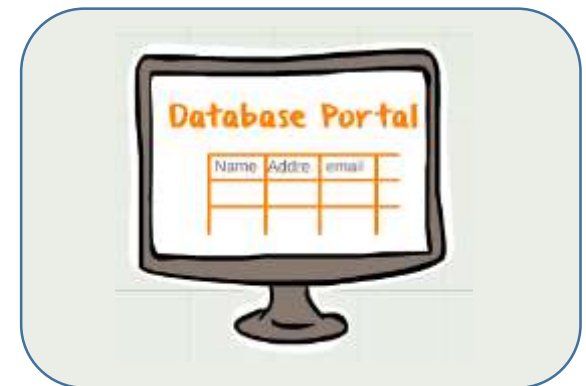
From zero to the LAG Database (2)

3. **LAG staff & managers** will be invited to create an **ECAS account** and to **update** their profiles.

- We are looking for ways to facilitate the creation of the ECAS accounts.

4. NSUs including FARNET will have the **right to access the back-access of the Database** with its ECAS account for:

- Updating the F/LAG list
- **Downloading all F/LAG information from the portal** including the specific one filled in by the F/LAGs.
