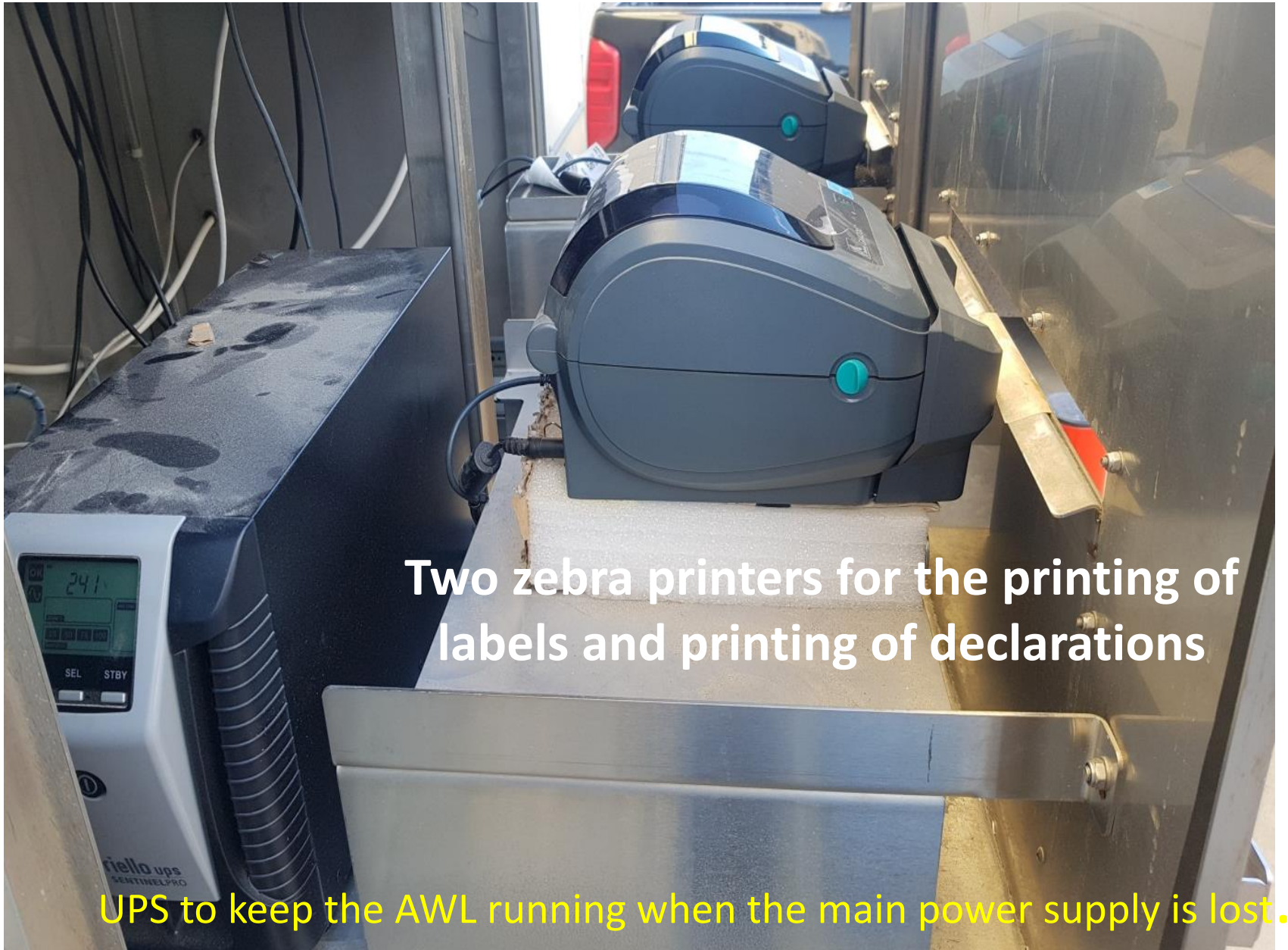

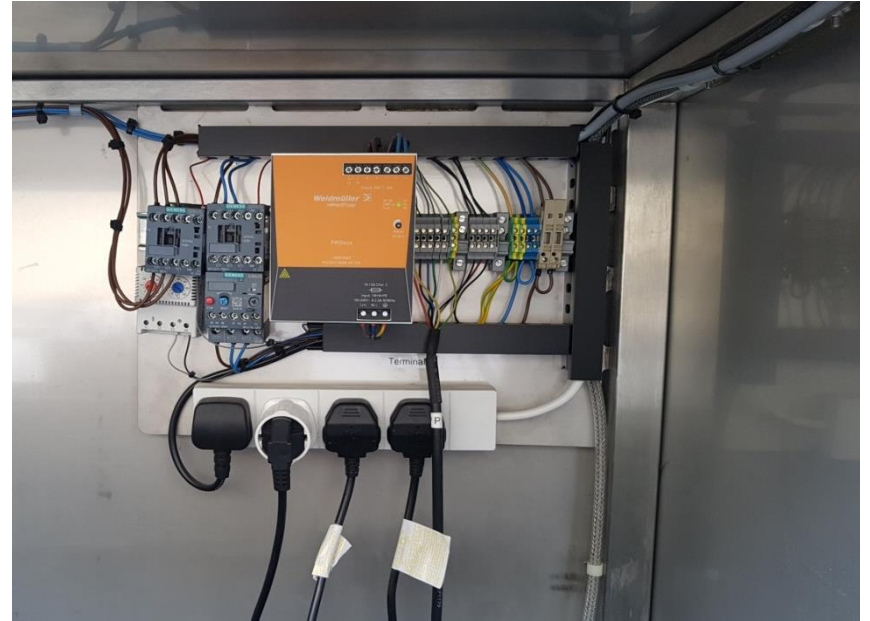


Two zebra printers for the printing of labels and printing of declarations

Water pump and water tank for the pumping of water to clean the weighing scale



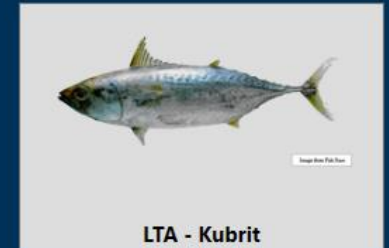
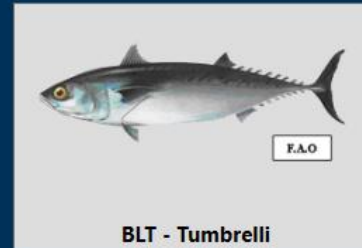
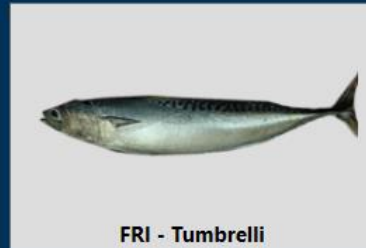

Background

- Simple tool for:
 - reporting /weighing/traceability of catches
 - Recording undersized fish for the landing obligation
- Fishers' reaction
 - Sceptical in the beginning
 - Uptake on the rise
 - Positive response
 - Request for more stations

EMFF

- Development:
 - Software : based on the existing elogbook
 - Hardware: 3-6 months delivery of 6 Units
- Costs
 - Purchase about €35,000 per Unit
 - Running about € 500 /year/unit
- Maintenance – In-house (2 Officers)
- EMFF Funding
 - Eligible for 90% EU 10% MT
