#### WP 2020 - Outline

- Every year the COM adopts a work programme for grants and procurement related to directly managed expenditure
- The draft Work Programme is transmitted to the EMFF Committee towards the end of the prior year for its opinion
- DG MARE is currently launching the process for the preparation of the 2020 Work Programme
- WP2020 provides for a significant degree of complementarity and continuity with the types of actions implemented in the previous years. This is the last WP under the current EMFF.

#### **WP 2020: Control and Enforcement**

Continuity of the implementation of EU control, inspection and enforcement systems notably through:

- Enhancement of IT infrastructure for a modern control system
- Missions to evaluate the implementation of the CFP rules



#### **WP 2020: Voluntary contributions**

Support to operations in the area of international relations notably via:

- Strengthening of the scientific basis for decision making and promoting sustainable fisheries in IATTC, ICCAT, IOTC, SPRFMO and WCPFC amongst others
- Financial contributions provided to UN organisations (FAO Regional projects)
- GFCM (Mediterranean and Black Sea)



#### **WP 2020**

#### **Governance and communication**

- Operating costs of the Advisory Councils, whose role has been recognised and reinforced over the years
- Provision and coordination of information and communication

#### **Market Intelligence**

 Support for the development and dissemination of market intelligence for fishery and aquaculture products



#### WP 2020: Scientific advice

Continuity of the provision of scientific deliverables for the purpose of sound and efficient fisheries management decisions under the CFP by:

- Support to ICES advisory process and STECF experts
- Enabling studies to be conducted that result in scientific advice



#### Scientific advice Examples of results to date

- Data collection: Regional Coordination Groups (RCG) and Regional Data Bases (RDB) strengthen cooperation in data collection
- Yearly scientific advice from ICES for TAC setting
- STECF advice in different fields (discard plans, Mediterranean stock assessment, data collection plans and reports, etc.)
- Four Framework Contracts for scientific advice studies set up by geographical areas and covering the whole spectrum of EU fisheries

Phase I Q2-Q3 2018


- ➤ Blue Invest events -> May, October 2018 / January 2019
