## **Updates to Commission proposal for a Council Regulation fixing for 2025 and 2026 the fishing opportunities for certain fish stocks, applicable in Union waters and, for Union fishing vessels, in certain non-Union waters [COM(2024) 506 final]**

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## **1. CORRECTIONS REGARDING FISHING OPPORTUNITIES IN THE NORTH-EAST ATLANTIC**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

In the Commission proposal, as updated through Commission services non-papers on 23 November, and 6 and 9 December 2024, the following should be corrected:

- Notifications about measures relating to European eel should be made during the entire calendar year 2025 and the period of application of Article 13. Therefore, Article 60 should be amended accordingly.
  
- Inter-annual flexibility of quotas should apply to Norway lobster in Iberian waters (NEP/9/3411) (Annex IA, Part A, Table 12). The TAC table should be updated accordingly. That error should be corrected.
  
- The TAC table for sandeel (Annex IA, Part B, Table 1) erroneously includes EU and UK quotas. That error should be corrected.
  
- The TAC table for LEZ/8ABDE (Annex IA, Part B, Table 33) includes erroneous quotas. That error should be corrected.
  
- The TAC table for ANF/8ABDE (Annex IA, Part B, Table 38) includes erroneous quotas. That error should be corrected.
  
- The TAC table for HKE/03A (Annex IA, Part B, Table 52) erroneously includes values marked 'pm'. That error should be corrected.
  
- The TAC table for RJE/07E (Annex IA, Part B, in Table 98) includes erroneous UK, EU and Member States quotas. That error should be corrected.
  
- The TAC table for JAX/08C (Annex IA, Part B, Table 121) includes erroneous quotas. That error should be corrected.
  
- Inter-annual flexibility of quotas should not apply to the Celtic Sea component (WHG/\*7XAD) of the Celtic Sea whiting TAC (WHG/7X7A-C) (Annex IA, Part B, Table 50). The TAC table should be updated accordingly. That error should be corrected.
  
- Inter-annual flexibility of quotas should apply to SRX/2AC4-C and SRX/07D (Annex IA, Part B, Tables 96 and 99). The TAC tables should be updated accordingly. Those errors should be corrected.

### **AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES**

In Article 60 the following point is added:

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## **2. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO FISHING OPPORTUNITIES IN FAROESE WATERS**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Since the Commission has not successfully concluded consultations on exchanges of fishing opportunities and access arrangements with the Faroe Islands, it is proposed to replace the figures marked as 'pm' (*pro memoria*) with 'to be established' in the TAC tables for fishing opportunities for stocks in Faroese waters.

### **AMENDMENTS TO THE ANNEXES**

In Annex IA, Tables 58, 103 and 104, and in Annex IB, Tables 5, 11, 12, 17, 26, 28 and 29, the figures marked as 'pm' for the Union and Member States quotas in Faroese waters should be replaced by 'to be established'.
