1. Amendments in relation to EU-NO-UK stocks

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Introduction

The EU held trilateral consultations with the United Kingdom and Norway on six shared and jointly managed stocks occurring within the areas under the jurisdiction of the three parties, with the aim to agree on the management of these stocks, including the fishing opportunities for 2024.

The EU conducted the trilateral consultations in accordance with the objectives and principles set out in Articles 2, 3, 28 and 33 of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013¹ as well as Article 5 of the North Sea multiannual plan² (MAP), and the Commission non-paper on the approach to be taken in the consultations with the United Kingdom and Norway to agree on fishing opportunities for shared stocks for 2024, endorsed by the Council on 12 October 2023. Consultations were conducted by the Commission in full coordination with the Council. The PECH Committee of the European Parliament was involved through periodic information and update sessions.

On 8 December 2023, the Commission agreed with the United Kingdom and Norway on the setting of fishing opportunities for 6 jointly managed stocks, which are transposed into 18 TACs. The agreement was laid down in the Agreed Record, which was signed by the Heads of Delegation of the Parties on 8 December 2023.

It is therefore proposed to set TACs corresponding to fishing opportunities for 2024 as agreed in the Agreed Record of the above-mentioned consultations with the United Kingdom and with Norway.

General approach

In line with the core conservation objective of the Common Fisheries Policy as set out in Article 2(2) of the CFP Regulation, also recalled in Article 3(1) of the North Sea MAP, the Union agreed with the United Kingdom and with Norway on 18 TACs for stocks with F_{MSY} advice (advice with levels of fishing opportunities expressing fishing pressure that delivers the maximum sustainable yield – 'MSY').

For three of those 6stocks (9 TACs: North Sea, Skagerrak and Kattegat, eastern English Channel North Sea herring; North Sea and Skagerrak plaice; and North Sea, Rockall and West of Scotland,

Skagerrak and Kattegat saithe), the fishing opportunities were set in line with the ICES advice and in accordance with the provisions of the North Sea MAP.

For Northern shelf cod (4 TACs: North Sea, Eastern Channel, Skagerrak and West of Scotland), the fishing opportunities were set below the MSY to support the recovery of the southern substock, which ICES estimates to be below the reference point for B_{pa} . Moreover, for Northern shelf cod, the EU will continue with the functionally linked measures first applied since 2020³. These measures include specific selectivity measures, area closures for protection of spawning aggregations of cod as well as the possibility for Member States to introduce National Cod Avoidance Plans.

For two of those 6 stocks (5 TACs: North Sea, West of Scotland and Skagerrak haddock and North Sea and Eastern Channel whiting), fishing opportunities were set at $F_{MSY lower}$ to take into account their interaction with cod in mixed fisheries. These fishing opportunities levels will contribute to the sustainable management of the Northern shelf cod stock, while reducing risks of choke in areas where haddock and whiting is found in high abundance.

2. Amendments in relation to EU-NO stocks

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The EU held bilateral consultations with Norway on one shared and jointly managed stock, whiting in the Skagerrak⁴, with the aim to agree on the management of this stock, including fishing opportunities for 2024. These consultations also covered the exchange of quotas and access arrangements. The EU conducted the bilateral consultations with Norway in accordance with the objectives and principles set out in Articles 2, 3, 28 and 33 of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013⁵ as well as Article 5 of the North Sea multiannual plan⁶ (MAP), and the Commission non-paper on the approach to be taken in the consultations with Norway to agree on fishing opportunities for shared stocks for 2024 endorsed by the Council on 12 October 2023. Consultations were conducted by the Commission in full coordination with the Council.

The bilateral consultations were successfully concluded on 8 December 2023 and the outcome was documented in three Agreed Records⁷. It is therefore proposed to update the Commission proposal, as updated by the Commission services' non-paper of 7 December 2023, and set the relevant fishing opportunities at the level agreed with Norway, together with the other provisions of the Agreed Records.

AMENDMENTS TO THE RECITALS

(59) The Union held bilateral consultations with Norway on one shared and jointly managed stock in the Skagerrak area (whiting), with the aim to agree on the management of this stock and fishing opportunities for 2024, as well as exchange of quotas and access arrangements. These consultations were conducted between 30 October and 8 December 2023, on the basis of the EU position endorsed by the Council on 12 October 2023. The outcome of the consultations was documented in Agreed Records, signed by the Head of Delegations on 8 December 2023. It is therefore proposed to set the relevant fishing

3. Amendments in relation to EU-UK stocks

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The EU and the United Kingdom signed the Written Record on fishing opportunities for 2024 on 6 December 2023. In that Written Record, they noted that, for some of the stocks included in Table 3 and Table 5 of Annex 1 to that Written Records, TACs are subject to trilateral EU- United Kingdom --Norway consultations. These trilateral consultations successfully concluded with the signature of the Agreed Record on 8 December 2023.

The EU and the United Kingdom subsequently held additional bilateral consultations on 8 December 2023 on fishing opportunities for 2024 for the stocks for which TACs were set in the trilateral consultations between the United Kingdom, the European Union and Norway, including Celtic Sea whiting and West of Scotland cod, in accordance with Article 498 of the TCA and in line with paragraph 4 of the Written record of fisheries consultations between the United Kingdom and the European Union for 2024 signed on 6 December 2023 ("the Written Record of 6 December 2023").

The outcome of the additional bilateral consultations was documented in an Addendum to the Written Record of 6 December 2023, which was signed on 8 December 2023. It is therefore proposed to set the level of the relevant fishing opportunities as set out in that supplementary Written Record.

4. Amendments in relation to coastal States stocks

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The bilateral EU-Norway consultations successfully concluded on 8 December 2023. The Commission proposal, as updated by the Commission services' non-paper of 21 November 2023, should therefore be updated to set EU and Member States quotas for the blue whiting stock to be fished in EU and international waters, and waters to which the EU vessels are granted access by third countries, which had been marked as '*pro memoria*'. These quotas should be set at a level that takes into account the transfers to Norway under the annual exchange of fishing opportunities for 2024. It is also proposed to update the relevant access provisions agreed during these bilateral consultations.

Moreover, in order to avoid overlapping provisions on the same subject matter, it is proposed to delete Table 59 relating to access in EU waters for Norway and the Faroe Islands to fish for blue whiting (*Micromesistius poutassou*). Such provisions are already covered in footnotes under the TAC for blue whiting in United Kingdom, Union and international waters of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8a, 8b, 8d, 8e, 12 and 14 (WHB/1X14).

In accordance with the procedure provided for in the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union, of the one part, and the Government of Greenland and the Government of Denmark, of the other part, and the Protocol implementing that Agreement⁸, the Joint Committee established the level of fishing opportunities available for the EU in Greenland waters in 2024. The level of fishing opportunities available for the EU in Greenland waters in 2024 was documented in the minutes of the Joint Committee meeting held from 21 to 23 November 2023 in Brussels.

It is therefore proposed that the relevant fishing opportunities be fixed at the level set out in those minutes, taking into account the transfers to Norway under the annual exchange of fishing opportunities.

The level of the fishing opportunities established for shrimp (*Pandalus borealis*) in Greenland waters of ICES subareas 5 and 14 take into account a reserve of 150 tonnes, which are to be used as currency in the event of potential purschase to Norway of additional shrimp quota in Norwegian waters of ICES subarea 4 in June 2024.
