- The Parties shall, upon request, inform each other of measures which might 3.2 be taken in order to monitor the catch of their vessels under quotas in the fishery zone of the other Party.
- 3.3 Vessels authorised to fish on 31 December 2007 may continue their activities in 2008 on the basis of this authorisation until the new list of vessels for 2008 has been approved.
