## EUMOFA - new service contract

- New service contract in force since December 2018
- Annual budget of 3,3 mios (- 20\%), renewable 3 times
- Awarded to a consortium: COGEA (lead) in a partnership with AND International, Business Integration Partner (BIP), Eurofish International Organisation (Eurofish) and Kontali Analyse
- Extended missions: focus on geographical coverage and data gaps in the value chain


## Functioning of the Observatory

Activities are articulated around 4 main tasks:

- Data collection, harmonisation and analysis
- Reports, studies, market analyses => WP 2019
- Communication and dissemination
- IT services
