

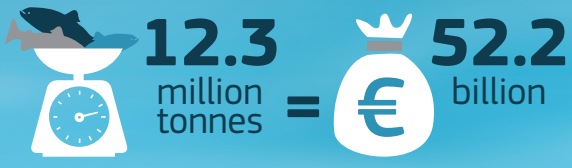

Apparent Consumption 2012

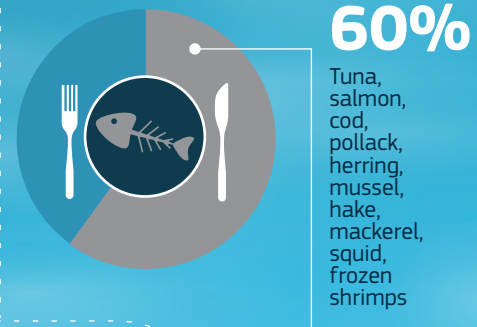
2012 Expenditure for fishery and aquaculture products (source: EUROSTAT)



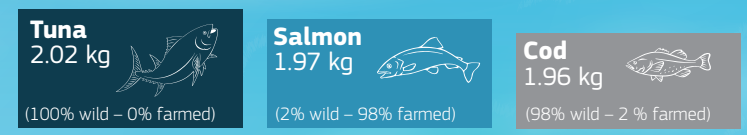
The EU is a major market for the consumption of seafood products, with 12.3 million tonnes consumed in 2011, worth a total of €52.2 billion. Fish consumption amounted to 23.81 kg per capita in 2012.



Some 10 species account for 60% of consumption.



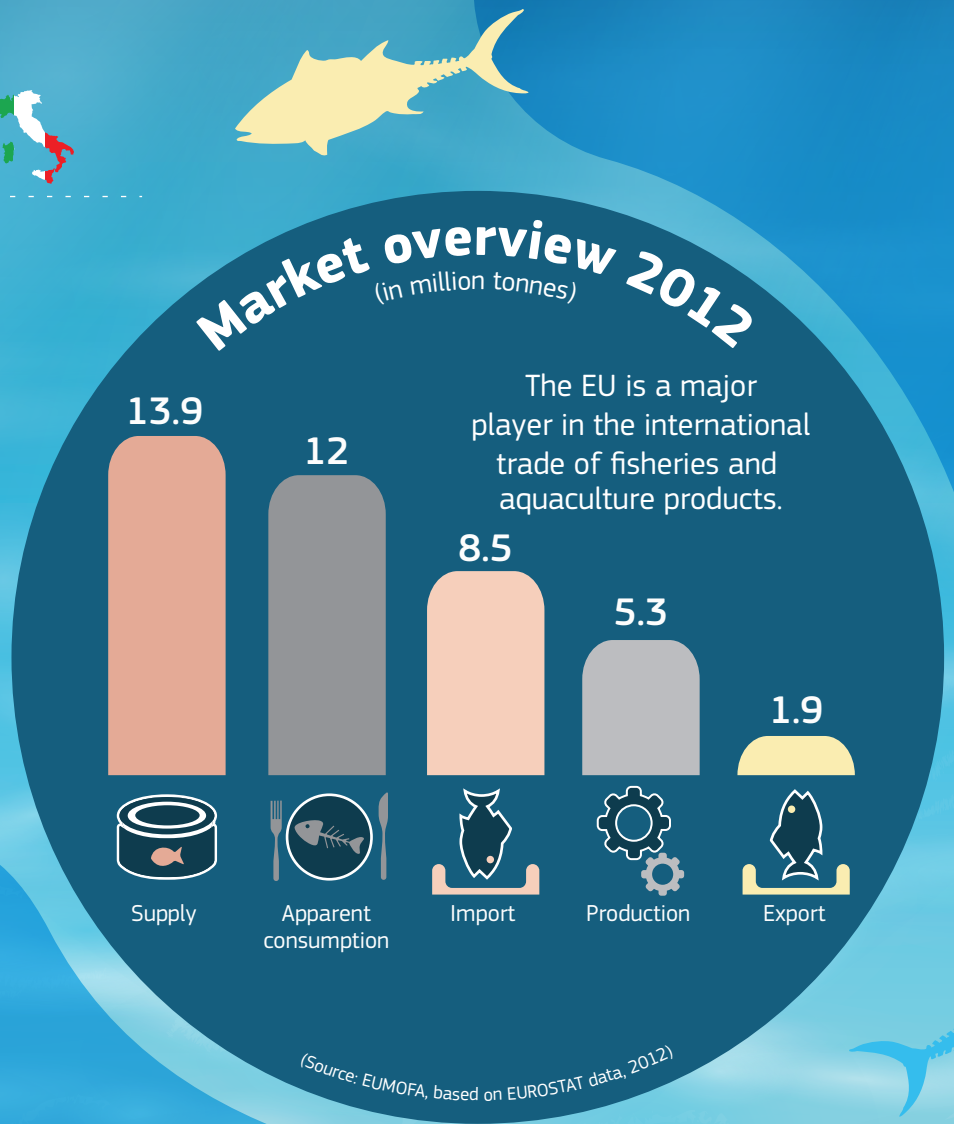
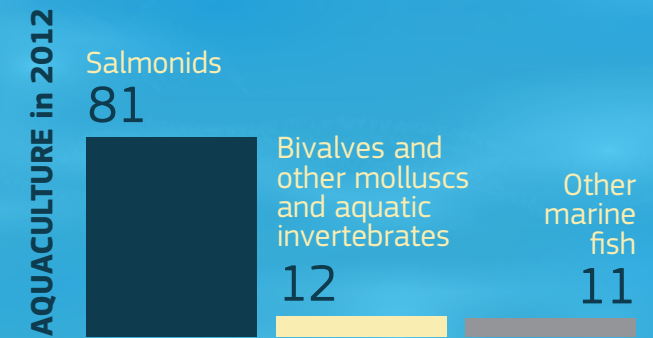
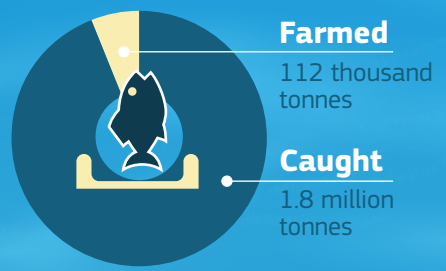
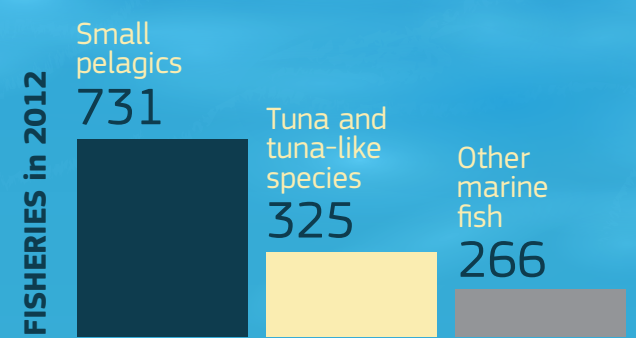
Main commercial species in apparent consumption (per capita) (EUMOFA data, 2011)

Main species exported (in thousand tonnes) (Source: EUMOFA based on EUROSTAT data, 2011)

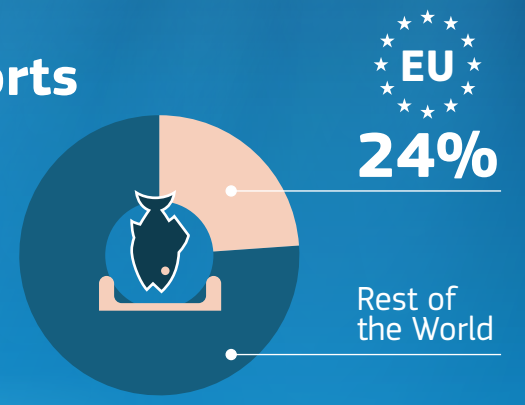
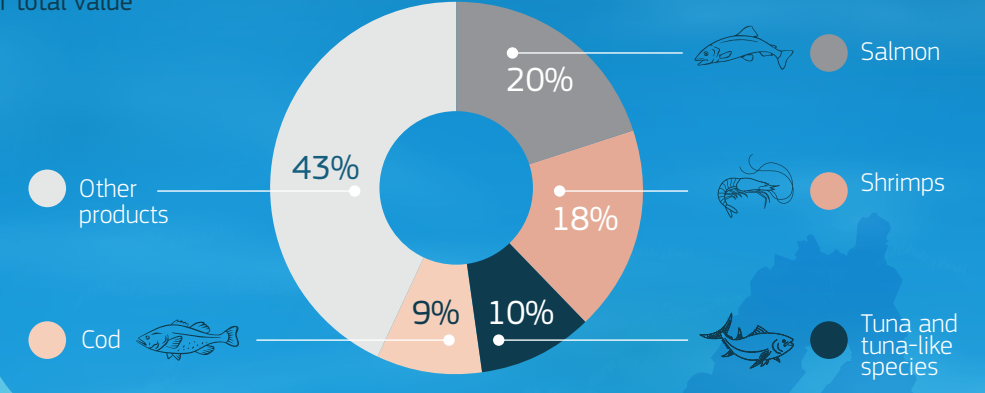


Imports
