EUROPEAN MARITIME, FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE FUND (EMFAF)

Community-led Local Development (CLLD) under the EMFAF in Slovenia focuses on supporting job creation, circular economy, environmental sustainability of the fisheries and aquaculture sector and the resilience of coastal areas. It aims to develop coastal and inland fishing and aquaculture communities across Slovenia directly involving fishers and aquaculture producers in the development of their local areas.

The Fisheries LAG strategies ensure that fishing and aquaculture areas better exploit their marine resources and benefit from the opportunities offered by the sustainable blue economy, capitalising on and strengthening environmental, cultural, social, and human resources. The strategies focus specifically on fisheries and aquaculture stakeholders, while also encouraging the diversification of the local communities as a whole.
