

CLLD Factsheet 2021-2027: CYPRUS

EUROPEAN MARITIME, FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE FUND (EMFAF)

Community-led Local Development (CLLD) under the EMFAF in Cyprus focuses on promoting a sustainable blue economy in coastal areas and promoting the development of fishing and aquaculture communities (priority no 3). The CLLD strategy in Cyprus ensures that local communities in fisheries and aquaculture areas take better advantage and benefit from the opportunities offered by the sustainable blue economy by harnessing and enhancing environmental, cultural, social and human resources, taking into account the need to achieve good environmental status and ecological management, as well as the need for sustainable management of Natura2000 areas for actions related to Natura2000 sites. The implementation of the CLLD approach is expected to promote the implementation of actions such as: utilizing natural and man-made environment, supporting fishers and businessmen through sponsorship schemes, professional training programs for fishers, cooperation activities and operational costs and coordination of local development strategy.
