



CLLD Factsheet 2021-2027: **LATVIA**

EUROPEAN MARITIME, FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE FUND (EMFAF)

Community-led Local Development (CLLD) under the EMFAF in Latvia focuses on supporting initiatives related to job creation, circular economy, environmental sustainability of fisheries and aquaculture sector, as well as the resilience of coastal areas. In the 2021-2027 programming period, CLLD is being applied exclusively in the coastal regions of the Baltic Sea and the Gulf of Riga, where the majority of Latvia's fisheries activities take place. The multi-fund approach continues to take place in the coastal areas of Latvia, where fisheries LAGs are also operating as LEADER LAGs, working with both the EMFAF and the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD).
