

#### FLAG Actions Contributing to the European Green Deal

This study provides information on projects funded by the European Maritime and Fish through Fisheries Local Action Groups (FLAGs) which contribute to the objectives of Eu Deal. In particular, it provides information on FLAG projects which contribute to the pre restoration of ecosystems and biodiversity, fostering more sustainable food systems,, and moving towards a circular economy. The findings outline that approximately 2 600 support the objectives of the Green Deal and the EU's 2030 Biodiversity Strategy.
